TEMPORARY LOCAL RULES

REVISED 13 December 2011

1. COURSE WORKS

Areas of the course defined by white stakes or white lines are GUR. Relief may be taken under Rule 25-1b.

2. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

For all play at South Lakes, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (eg gradient, wind speed or temperature) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.

3. GRASSED BUNKER FACES

Grassed Bunker Faces are neither part of the bunker (hazard) nor closely mown areas. Relief without penalty for an embedded ball may only be taken when another Temporary Local Rule provides relief from embedded balls through the green.

4. PATHS

Artificially surfaced paths are those to which dolomite has been applied. Relief may be taken under Rule 24-2b (Immovable Obstruction). Tracks that are not predominantly artificially surfaced are integral parts of the course and the ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable (Rule 28); see also temporary local rule 5 below.

5. MULCH

Apart from Garden Beds and the mulch on the path adjacent the 9th tee, any mulch laid on the course is an integral part of the course and the ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable (Rule 28). Relief under Rule 25-1 may be taken from the mulch on the path adjacent the 9th tee.

6. AERATION HOLES

Through the green, a ball that comes to rest in or on an aeration hole may be lifted without penalty, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to the spot where it lay, but not nearer the hole.

7. COMPULSORY GUR

The mounded area to the left hand side of the 8th Green defined by white pegs is **Ground Under Repair from which play is prohibited**. If a player's ball lies in the area, or if it interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the player **may** take relief under Rule 25-1b or, as an additional option, drop a ball in the nearest marked drop zone.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:

Match play – Loss of hole; Stroke play – Two strokes (unless a general penalty applies)
